2022 Has Been A Very Busy Year For All Of Us at the City

If you look across the City of Live Oak, you will see two distinct landscapes; a large portion is residential, but a sizable portion is commercial businesses. Both receive the same excellent city services, and both are very dependent upon each other for success.

Live Oak provides a wide range of municipal services to its citizens, businesses, and visitors. All of these services are made available through revenues paid to the City. Most cities are structured in a way that fees and taxes pay for a majority of the services they provide to its customers. Live Oak is no exception to that structure. However, Live Oak becomes a little more unique with the makeup of its revenues. Many people believe the

biggest revenue stream of a City is property taxes. But in Live Oak, that is not the case. While taxes account for over 73 percent of the revenue paid into the City's General Fund, over 61 percent of Live Oak's total taxes come from sales tax received from Live Oak businesses. Property taxes account for 38 percent of total taxes.

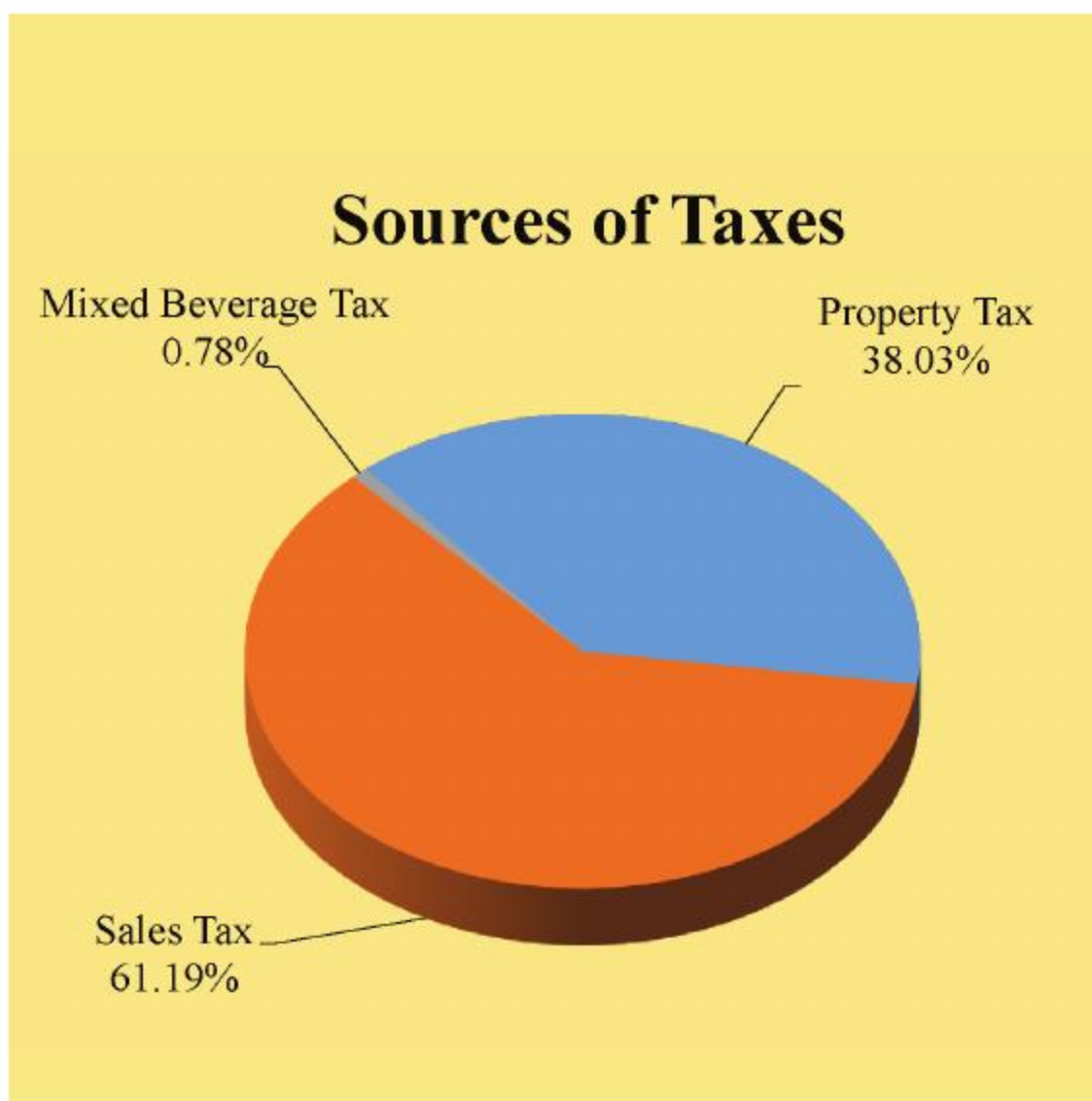
Live Oak businesses charge a sales tax on taxable purchases of 8.25%. This rate breaks down in the following:

- 6.25% - State sales tax
- 1.00% - City of Live Oak general revenue
- 0.50% - City of Live Oak revenue for property tax relief.
- 0.50% - Live Oak Economic Development Corporation

Courtesy of the successes our great business partners around the City are having, sales taxes paid to the City allows the property tax rate for the City of Live Oak to remain one of the lowest in the area at \$0.410220 per \$100 of taxable property valuation. Live Oak is extremely fortunate.

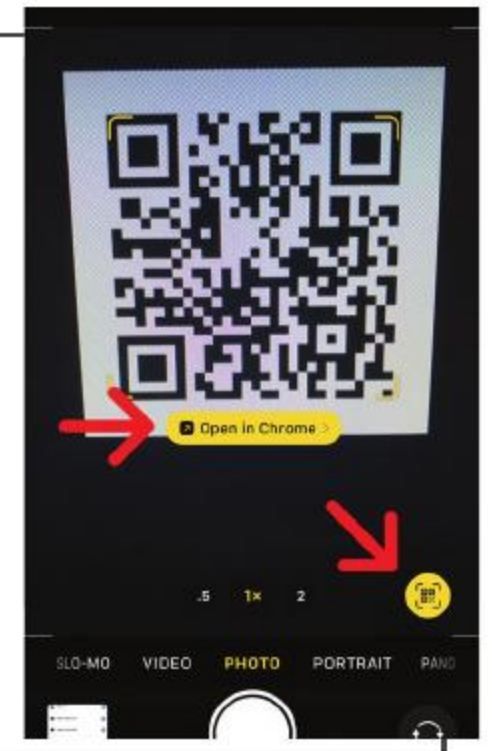
How do I scan a QR code?

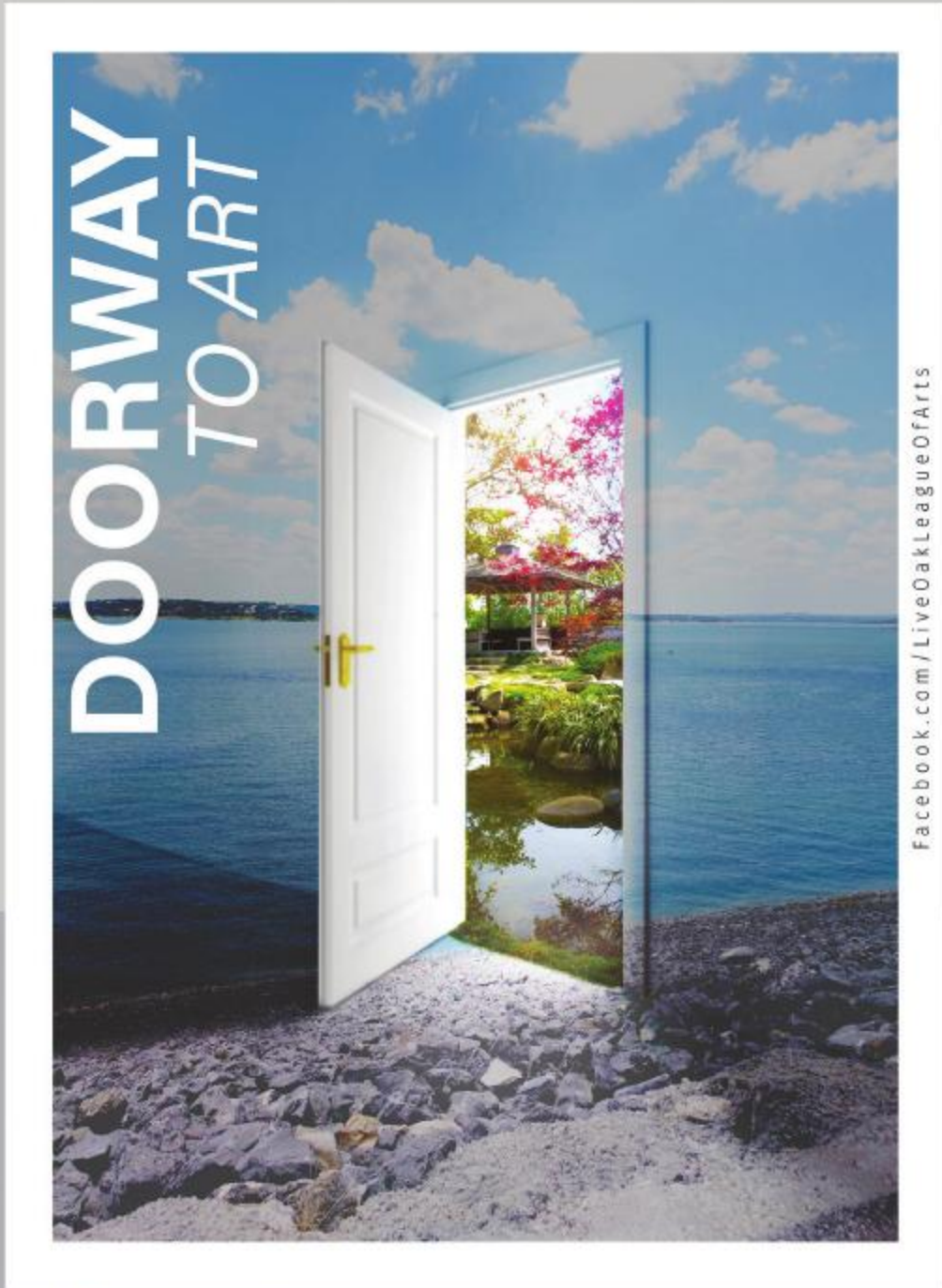

As we start grilling, remember to be safe and follow these safety tips

- Only use your grill outside, and keep it at least 10 feet from your home.
- Keep a 3-foot safe zone around your grill.
- Open your gas grill before lighting.
- Keep an eye on your grill, and fire pit.



DO NOT WALK AWAY FROM THEM WHEN THEY ARE LIT

- Clean your grill after each use to remove grease that can start a fire.
- ONCE THEY HAVE COOLED, place the coals from your grill in a metal can with a lid.

Live Oak would like to remind everyone of the City Ordinance regarding fireworks.

Chapter 8. Article III. Sec 8-43 Prohibited.

It shall be unlawful for any person to manufacture, assemble, store, transport, receive, keep, sell, offer, or have in his possession with intent to sell, use, discharge, cause to be discharged, ignite, detonate, fire or otherwise set in action any fireworks of any description.

Leave the fireworks to the professionals and visit a safe professional fireworks show.

Wayland Baptist University - San Antonio Announces the Retirement of Dr. Jim Antenen



On June 30, Dr. Antenen will officially retire as the Executive Director and Campus Dean of Wayland Baptist University – San Antonio where he spent the past 20 years. Recently awarded emeritus status by the Wayland Board of Trustees, Antenen said that while working at Wayland turned out to be his “dream job.”

Antenen spent 21 years in the Air Force and served three years as Executive Vice President and then President of the Community College of the Air Force and was commander of the Occupational Measurement Center at Randolph Air Force Base in San Antonio before he retired from the United States Air Force. Once he retired into civilian life, he took on a role at USAA developing leadership. Dr. Antenen has worked with numerous organizations in areas such as strategic planning and leader development, and he published articles and books dealing with organizational management, leadership, and adult education.

Under Dr. Antenen’s visionary leadership, the San Antonio campus nearly doubled in size to almost 2,000 students, established the WBU School of Nursing, increased capacity with the relocation of the campus, and began offering 6 new undergraduate and 7 new graduate degree programs. Dr. Antenen challenged everyone to become the best version of themselves through Christ-centered education and believes that Wayland provides an opportunity for people to rewrite their future!

In recognition of the devotion and distinguished service of Dr. Jim Antenen, Dr. Michael Davis, a friend of the Wayland Baptist University San Antonio, recently established the Antenen Rewrite Your Future fund with an initial gift of \$25,000.

The Antenen Rewrite Your Future fund celebrates the leadership and character of Dr. Jim Antenen and provides funds to help working adults accomplish their academic goals through Wayland. The fund will be used to support struggling, working adults determined to obtain their higher educational degree through Wayland and will be available to those students who have shown outstanding performance or who bring special qualities or abilities to Wayland, with consideration being given to academic achievement, financial need, character, and qualities of leadership.

We developed color-coded energy conservation levels with tips appropriate to the anticipated demand for energy. Most days will be Green Days and we'll advocate for everyday conservation. If additional conservation is needed during peak energy demand, we will declare a Yellow Day and ask the community to increase their conservation efforts.

Orange or Red Alerts will be issued if ERCOT, the statewide grid manager, declares grid reliability is at risk.

BE PREPARED

Don't wait for an emergency or power outage, make a family emergency plan now. If you have medical equipment that requires electricity or medicines that need refrigeration, check with your doctor when making your plan. Assemble a power outage emergency kit.

The City of Live Oak has partnered with WM to provide trash collection service twice weekly, recycle service collection once every two weeks, curbside bulk waste and brush bundle collection once per month. WM is also providing unlimited concierge collection of household hazardous waste (HHW) through its At Your Door Special CollectionSM service for all Live Oak residential customers.

COLLECTION SCHEDULE

Trash collection is twice a week. Recycle collection is once every two weeks. Bulk and brush-bundle collection occur curbside once a month.

CARTS

WM will deliver two NEW 96-gallon carts to each residence in Q3 2022.

- 1 - 96-gallon green cart for items considered trash
- 1 - 96-gallon cart with a yellow lid for recyclable items

Residents must use their new WM 96-gallon carts after receiving them. After receipt of the WM 96-gallon carts, no resident-owned or store-bought container will be used in servicing either trash or recycle material.

GENERAL COLLECTION GUIDELINES

Please follow the guidelines below to ensure trash or recyclable material collection. *Note: Collections may not occur at the same time of day each week.

- To ensure collection, trash or recyclable carts must be at the point of collection no later than 7:00 AM on the scheduled collection day. Place cart with wheels against the curb and handles facing the home.
- Do not include paint, motor oil, or other hazardous items.
- Do not obstruct the collection of trash or recyclable material by parking vehicles in the vicinity.
- Keep a 3-foot space between trash or recyclable material and other objects. With automated collection, all trash and recycling must be contained within the trash cart with the lid closed. WM will not collect items outside the carts.

OBSERVED HOLIDAYS

Waste Management observes the following holidays, collection will not occur: **New Year's Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Memorial Day, Thanksgiving, and Christmas.**

BULK & BRUSH ITEMS

Curbside bulk waste and brush bundle collection is monthly and is limited to six (6) cubic yards in total size. No construction or landscape maintenance debris may be placed at the curb for collection if generated by a third-party contractor, i.e. landscaper, tree-trimmer, etc. It is the third-party contractor's responsibility to haul off this material.

Brush Requirements

- Branches and tree trimmings must be no greater than six inches (6") in diameter and be cut, tied, and bundled in four foot (4') lengths weighing no more than forty to fifty pounds (40-50 lbs.).
- Leaves and lawn clippings are allowable if bagged and remain within the total monthly limit of six (6) cubic yards.

Bulk Waste

- Appliances with Freon® removed
- Carpet (cut into 4-foot bundles)
- Furniture and mattresses
- Sinks, toilets, and drained/empty water heaters

NOT Bulk Waste

- Appliances containing Freon®
- Batteries and paint
- Concrete, brick, asphalt, and roofing
- Construction debris from a contractor
- Gasoline, oil, and filters
- Tires, vehicles, and parts

EXTRA BAGS OF TRASH

Residents who have extra bags of trash but do not need an additional cart, must place a pink tag on each bag. Pink tags are available to purchase at City Hall for a nominal fee.

Interested in building or buying a new shed?

Around this time of year, many Live Oak citizens are inquiring about sheds and the requirements for a permit. We have laid out the permitting requirements below for sheds placed on private property. If you would like to place a shed on your property WITHOUT a permit, all of the following must apply:

- The shed is less than or equal to 120 total square feet, and;
- Not be placed on a poured concrete foundation, and;
- There are no additional utilities, (i.e. HVAC, plumbing, electrical, etc.) that will be added to the shed.

Note: If you would like an alternative foundation to poured concrete, without having to pull a permit, concrete pavers or blocks can be used as a base.

If you would like to place a shed on your property that is outside the limits of the above requirements, you will need to pull a permit. If any of the following apply to your situation, a PERMIT WILL BE REQUIRED:

- The shed is over 120 square feet, and/or;
- You are going to be pouring a concrete foundation for the shed; and/or
- You will be adding utilities (i.e. HVAC, plumbing, electrical, etc.) to the shed.

Weeds, weeds, weeds!

Warmer weather is creeping in and with that comes lots and lots of weeds. We understand that weeds are a lot of work, especially in the spring and summer time in Texas. This is a friendly reminder the City's ordinances do not allow weeds or grass to be over twelve (12) inches on any property and grass clippings blown into the street or left in the street after mowing is not allowed.

Tip: After mowing, you can take a leaf blower and blow all left-over grass clippings back into the grass, getting the clippings off the street and sidewalks. This prevents the clippings from accumulating and from receiving a notice from the Code Compliance team.

Life happens during the growing season, such as vacations, family emergencies, etc., preventing you from



Additionally, all sheds (with/without a permit) CANNOT:

- Be occupied
- Be placed within five (5) feet of the home or a fence
- Have any electrical extension cords running to it, or
- Cannot have square footage exceeding both: one third the square footage of the backyard and one half the square footage of the home (this is including all existing sheds and structures on the property).

Permits for a shed over 120 sq feet are priced at \$50 (base fee) + \$0.50/sq ft. Permits for a poured concrete foundation are priced at a flat fee of \$150.00.



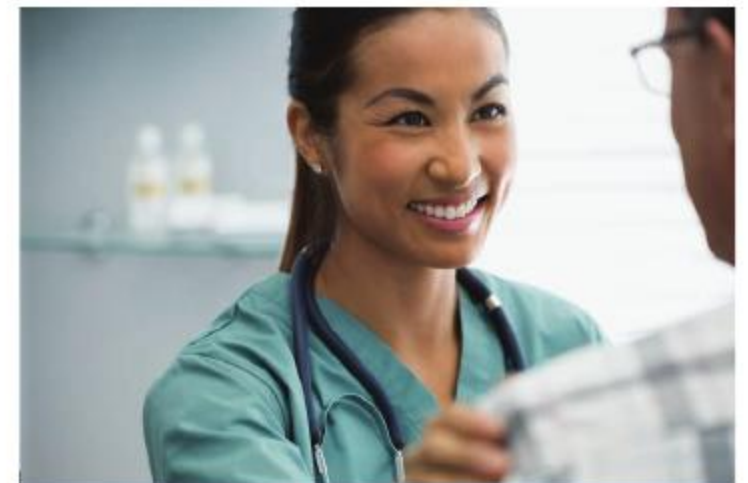
