


#### **Utilities Department** Fiscal Management - Water & Sewer Utilities

Every year during the budget process, City staff is tasked with analyzing the City's Utility Funds for proper fiscal alignment. This analysis is a multi-step process that determines if the City's utility rates are set accordingly to provide adequate revenues to cover all system expenses and debt liabilities and to maintain proper cash reserves necessary to provide high-level services to the customer.

There are many goods and services necessary to operate a premier water and sewer utility. The costs of these goods and services have been on the rise for the past year. It was determined an increase would be necessary to the water and sewer rates to cover the increases. At the February 14, 2023, council meeting, the proposed rate increases were presented and approved by City Council. The new rates went into effect on April 1, 2023, and will be reflected on the May 2023 billing cycles.

The City of Live Oak works very closely with the other utility providers in the area to help keep expenses down and rates very competitive. These providers are the San Antonio Water System (SAWS), Cibolo Creek Municipal Authority (CCMA), and the San Antonio River Authority (SARA). The City of Live Oak continues to provide a premier utility service to its residential and commercial customers with some of the lowest rates in the region. That is something we can all brag about.



Crime Fighting Has Taken Its Toll

In 1962, President John F. Kennedy proclaimed May 15th as National Peace Officers Memorial Day, he also proclaimed the calendar week in which May 15th falls as National Police Week. Established by a joint resolution of Congress in 1962, National Police Week pays special recognition to those law enforcement officers who have lost their lives in the line of duty for the safety and protection of others.



Since the first recorded police death in 1786. there have been more than 23.000 law enforcement officers killed in the line of duty. Currently, there are 23,229 names engraved on the walls of the National Law **Enforcement Officers** Memorial. The New York City Police Department has lost more officers in the line of duty than any other department,

with 954 deaths. Texas has lost 1,831 officers, more than any other state.

As of December 31, 2022, 226 federal, state, tribal, and local law enforcement officers died in the line of duty in 2022. This is a dramatic decrease of approximately 61% from the

586 officers killed in 2021. The massive decrease in lineof-duty deaths for 2022 is almost entirely related to the significant reduction in Covid-19 deaths.

The Live Oak Junior Police Academy is held June 26th through 30th. Cadets attending the academy will experience various fields of police work. The cadets start the week by going through an obstacle course that is part of the police departments hiring process.

Cadets also receive hands on training in crime scene investigation and lifting latent fingerprints. Applications are still being accepted to be a part of the Junior Police Academy.



#### When and How to Use Fire Extinguishers

Always put your safety first, if you are not confident in your ability to use a fire extinguisher, get out of your residence and call 911.

The Live Oak Fire Department cautions you to evaluate the use of the fire extinguisher and to ensure:

- Everyone has left or is leaving the home.
- The Fire Department has been called.
- The fire is small, not spreading, and there is not much smoke.
- Your back is to an exit you can use quickly.
- You remember the acronym PASS:

**P**ULL THE PIN. AIM LOW AT THE BASE OF THE FIRE. **S**QUEEZE THE HANDLE SLOWLY. **S**WEEP THE NOZZLE SIDE TO SIDE.

• REMEMBER, NOT ALL FIRE EXTINGUISHERS WILL WORK ON EVERY FIRE. For home use, the NFPA recommends a multi-purpose extinguisher (ABC type) large enough to put out a small fire, but not so heavy that it will be difficult to handle.













#### National Public Works Week May 21 – 27 Team Live Oak's Superheroes

National Public Works Week is observed during the third full week of May to recognize the importance of Public Works. There are multiple employees in our City that make up our Public Works Department, and we would like to highlight their duties and the amazing job they do.

The utilities crew keep the water running in our homes while you and I are sleeping. These employees often work through long stretches of shifts and are always on call for emergencies. On holidays, someone is ready to step away from their family gathering after receiving a phone call from dispatch to repair a water main break, leak, or stoppage.

The streets and storm-water crew responsibilities include preventative maintenance such as street sweeping, pavement rehabilitation, and keeping storm drains clear. The crew, along with the Assistant Director of Public Works, put in many long shifts to plan for and accommodate any emergencies that arise. These individuals will be out spreading sand on the streets early in the morning if we have freezing temperatures or placing barricades for areas of flooding. Weather doesn't wait for 8 to 5 working hours!

Have you driven out to the park lately to enjoy the new Acorn playground, or to take a long stroll around the lake, or play a round of disc golf? Our parks crew does an outstanding job of maintaining over 100 acres of parkland, and the municipal

swimming pool, and assisting with special events. These men are working hard to keep Live Oak's park system premier.

Our fleet crew is another part of Public Works one might not think about. These employees keep City automobiles, heavy equipment, and rescue vehicles in top condition and ready to go.

The responsibility of providing facility operations and maintenance of all city buildings falls on the Facilities Manager. Facilities staff are constantly making routine improvements such as painting, repairing HVAC units, or securing contractors for a larger project or repair.

Our Recreation and Special Events Manager works hard developing and implementing one of a kind city-wide, special events. In addition, she oversees the Municipal swimming operations, city facility usage, and youth sports. She is the liaison for civic groups within the City. It takes incredible planning and organization to get an event started. One single event can take months of preparation. The next time you and your family are enjoying a city event in our streets or park, step back, look around, and notice the things going on around you. You will see the coordination of many volunteers and city employees making the event possible.


Administrative personnel also play a huge role in the day-to-day operations of Public Works. These employees are the first friendly faces you will see if you visit the Public Works building. On any given day, you will see staff answering and directing calls, processing work orders, managing the electronic marquees, and administratively assisting supervisors in a variety of ways.

Finally, our Department Managers and Supervisors prepare reports related to Public Works activities. They are involved with administrative work, dealing directly and in depth with citizens, employees, city engineers, other department managers, consultants, contractors, city administrators, and City Council in problem resolution. They also oversee all city contracts from new buildings to street construction projects.

We would like to recognize these fine men and women for the outstanding jobs they do on daily basis. If you happen to see any of these fine men and women out and about working in the neighborhoods or by the Municipal Complex, give them a shout out or high five. Let them know how much they are appreciated each day! They truly are some of our finest heroes who make the City of Live Oak a great place to live, learn, work, and play!







During the upcoming summer months, temperatures can reach dangerous levels. With the high heat index, temperatures can be particularly hazardous for children, the elderly, those with special needs, and pets. In addition to discomfort and fatigue, extremely high temperatures can cause heat cramps, exhaustion, and stroke. To protect yourself, your family, and your neighbors, please familiarize yourself with the following terms and symptoms:

Stay out of the sun. If you must be in the sun, wear sunscreen. Avoid overexertion and strenuous outdoor activities. Wear lightweight, light-colored, loose-fitting clothes that cover as much skin as possible to prevent sunburn. Consume plenty of non-alcoholic, non-caffeinated fluids. Water, diluted juices, and electrolyte solutions are best. Stay away from carbonated drinks.

Avoid alcohol.

Stay in the shade or under awnings as much as possible.
Keep rooms well-ventilated with air conditioners and fans. Keep your windows open if you don't have a fan or air conditioning.
If you are in need of a box fan and cannot afford one, contact (210) 653-9140 ext. 2379 to inquire about PROJECT COOL. This program loans out box fans while supplies last.

Cool down with periodic cool baths or showers.

Never leave children, the elderly, or those who require special care during periods of intense summer heat.

Make a special effort to check on your neighbors during a heat wave, especially if they are seniors, young children or people with special needs or if they live alone.

Seniors and others who may be sensitive to extreme heat should contact friends, neighbors, or relatives periodically throughout the day. Seek help if you feel symptoms of heat-related illnesses.

## Live Oak Emergency Management would like you to remember:

If you are in need of a smoke detector and meet the qualifications, you may be eligible to have a smoke detector placed in your home. Eligibility requirements are as follows:

You are a current resident in Live Oak.

You own and live in your home. RENTAL PROPERTIES DO NOT QUALIFY. You are living on a low income.

If you meet these requirements and would like the fire department to come to your home and install a smoke detector, (NOT INTERCONNECTED) call the Live Oak Fire Department at (210) 653-9140 x2379 or send an email to rluna@liveoaktx.net.







#### City Permits

You may have noticed bright green permits posted around your neighborhoods. The bright green paper you've noticed in the windows are City permits. Permits are issued by the City to ensure the quality of the projects in town are safe, constructed properly, and allowed. The permit process protects the resident having the work done and the neighbors close by. A permit must be posted in a conspicuous location and visible from the public right of way throughout the entirety of the project until completion. Below are some frequently asked questions:

Q. Do I need a permit to build on or make changes to my property?

A. If you are adding, altering, or modifying a building (including the roof), fence, electrical, irrigation, plumbing, air conditioning of your residence, adding a new structure like a pool or shed over 200 square feet in size, a building permit is required. A permit is not required for painting, sheet rock repair, replacing a toilet or sink as long (as the P-trap is not removed or altered), and installing phone or Internet cables. These are just a few of the exemptions found in the International Residential Code 2021. For the complete list of exempted items, visit this website for free access to our adopted International Code Council books at https://codes.iccsafe.org/codes/i-codes

Q. Do I need a permit to plant trees or decorative plants in my yard?
A. No. However it is recommended that an irrigation system be installed to help maintain your investment and this will require a permit. The City Code of Ordinances in Chapter 24 Zoning, Article VI, Sections 24.58 and 24.59, has recommended plants that will thrive in our area. **Q.** Do I need a permit for temporary storage on my property such as PODS.?

**A.** Yes, temporary storage units such as P.O.D.S require a permit that is good for 30 days. The unit must not be placed in the grass.

**Q.** Does my contractor apply for the permit when I hire them to do a project?

**A.** This question is asked often. If the property is your homestead, you may obtain a building permit for alterations or additions to your residence. However keep in mind that you are now liable for all the work complying with code and will be taking responsibility for the workers on your property.

Work governed by the State of Texas such as electrical, plumbing, air conditioning, and Irrigation must be permitted by the contractor licensed by the State of Texas through the Texas Department of Licensing and Regulation, the Texas State Board of Plumbing Examiners, or the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality. You cannot obtain a permit for anyone other than yourself. Therefore, you must do the work mentioned in this section, not someone else who may offer you a great deal if you obtain the permit from the City. If the work is done improperly, it can cost you much more than the money in the end.

Lastly, building permits are not transferable. If you change contractors, a new permit must be obtained. If you do hire a contractor, make sure they post the green permit in a visible location. Protect yourself. There are many good contractors in the Live Oak area, but unfortunately, there are those who will take advantage of you. 


