





Dear Residents,

Live Oak takes pride in being a forward-thinking and progressive city. With that progression includes our commitment to ensuring the residents are well informed. In this issue of the Hometown News magazine, I provide a view into the City's projects currently underway or recently completed which include improvements to the municipal pool and two new vehicles in production for the Live Oak Fire Department.

Before the 2024 Pool Season, staff began preparing the municipal pool to receive a new liner. The material used is a 60-mil thick, 2-ply reinforced textured PVC pool renovation membrane. The liner was designed for maximal product durability and ease of maintenance over time and is approximately 5,712 square feet with approximate depths that range from 3 to 5 feet.



he kid pool also received the same liner at 252 square feet with a depth of approximately 2 feet. The life expectancy for the new liners ranges between 10 and 15 years. The old liner



provided 11 years of service. The liner installation project was completed in March, and the pool was refilled on March 15th ready for the new season.











The much-anticipated new engine is an all-hazards rescue engine designed to respond to structure fires, EMS, rescue, motor vehicle extrication/ stabilization and HAZMAT calls. It is equipped with a Compressed Air Foam

System (CAFS) which helps reduce water damage when fighting attic fires and gets more credit under Insurance Office Services (ISO) which could lower insurance rates in Live Oak.

The new ladder truck is a Midmount 100-foot design with a quick set-up configuration that puts the truck in service in 26 seconds compared to 3 to 4 minutes for the ladder truck it is replacing. Rear steering will make this truck much easier and safer for our first responders to drive. Both apparatuses will be completed in April or May and in service by Spring 2024.



#### Graduation Season is Here!





The Live Oak Police Department s hosting its Annual Junior Police Academy June 17th to 21st, 2024. This weeklong, free camp is open to youth ages 9 to 12 years old and limited to the first 40 youth who sign up. Live Oak residents have priority for acceptance into this program. Students

MUST attend school in the Judson Independent School District (JISD) or the Northeast Independent School District (NEISD) Systems. Attendance in local charter and home school are acceptable as well. A very exciting and fun-filled week is planned!

Every day will include a learning session, an activity pertaining to the learning session, and a craft at the end of most days. The Junior Police Academy is scheduled for Monday - Friday, 8am to 12:30pm. Children between the ages of 9 to 12 years of age may apply. The children

will participate in numerous events that will encourage teamwork, build their self-esteem, motivate them to help others, and themselves, and promote a positive attitude. The goals and objectives for the Junior Police Academy Camp include:

- Teach the mission & core values of the Live Oak Police Department & other public safety services available to them.



of construction, a groundbreaking ceremony was held on April 3rd and construction is now underway with a scheduled completion ranging from late 2024 to mid-2025.



#### Here are some steps to a fire escape plan:

- Draw a floor plan for each floor of your home, including windows and doors. For each room, find two ways out, and label them on your plan.
- Designate one adult to assist with babies, young children, or family members who need extra help getting out safely and have a back-up plan in case the primary person is overcome by smoke or is not home.
- Decide on a safe meeting place for your family. Make sure it is a safe distance away from the home.
- Make sure everyone knows what to do and where to go in case of fire. ٠
- Test your smoke alarms twice a year! •
- Teach your child to get low and crawl on the ground, where the air is less smoky. •
- Practice your fire escape plan twice a year.

#### **City of Live Oak's Water and Sewer Utility Rates**

We want to take this opportunity to provide information regarding the recent change to the City of Live Oak's water and sewer utility rates, which were adopted at the February 27th City Council meeting with an effective date of April 1, 2024. The City Council adopted a 9% increase to the wastewater rates for both commercial and residential accounts.

The City Council adopted a 3.56% average increase for residential water accounts that are serviced by City of Live Oak Utilities only and a 4% average for commercial water accounts. The budgeted increase was a 5% increase. If you receive your utility bill from SAWS, then your water rates are adopted by SAWS.



#### **Gearing Up For Summer Safety**

The Live Oak Fire Department would like to remind everyone to be safe, as the summer months approach.

- Stay Hydrated. Drink eight or more glasses of water per day to stay healthy.
- Know the side effects of medication. Some medications have side effects such as drowsiness or sun sensitivity.
- Stay cool. Stay in the A/C or GO SWIMMING!!!!
- Wear light loose-fitting clothing. Wear breathable clothing and light colors that reflect the sun.
- Have Emergency contacts. Have a list of people to call in case of emergency.
- Wear Bike helmets. They should cover the forehead and sit level on the child's head. Fasten the helmet tight enough that two fingers fit between the chin and strap.

#### **Fireworks are Prohibited**

Live Oak would like to remind everyone of the City Ordinance regarding fireworks.

#### Chapter 8. Article III, Section 8-43 Prohibited.

It shall be unlawful for any person to manufacture, assemble, store, transport, receive, keep, sell, offer, or have in his possession with intent to sell, use, discharge, cause to be discharged, ignite, detonate, fire, or otherwise set in action any fireworks of any description.

#### So leave the fireworks to the professionals and visit a safe, professional firework show.

#### **Smoke and Carbon Monoxide Detectors**

We should all remember to change out smoke detectors batteries at least once (1) a year, but how often do we remember to check the carbon monoxide detector? Referencing First Alert, if your carbon monoxide alarm has replaceable batteries, they should be changed at least every six (6) months. Carbon monoxide poisoning is common during the winter months as we start to use heating appliances. You can also contact the Live Oak Fire Department at 210-653-9140, ext. 2379, and inquire about both smoke alarms and the Kemeth Cole Carbon Monoxide Detector programs.

# Thank you for using the Single Use Disposal System!

The Single Use Disposal Systems (SUDS) are a convenient and environmentally friendly way to dispose of your unused or expired prescription medications. The pre-paid **TakeAway Envelope** allows you to mail your unused and expired prescriptions from the privacy of your own home. They are incinerated unopened keeping themout of our drinking water.

#### WHAT HAPPENS TO THE ENVELOPE AFTER IT IS MAILED?

The envelopes containing the medications are sent directly to a treatment facility to be incinerated.

#### **ARE TAKEAWAY ENVELOPES SAFE?**

Yes, the TakeAway Envelopes are safe. Using the TAE is safer then flushing or throwing the medications in the trash. Incinerating the medications limit the environmental damage that medications can have by preventing them from polluting our drinking water.

The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) recommends incineration as the method of drug destruction, which meets the Department of Enforcement Agency's (DEA) standard.

#### CAN NEEDLES OR INHALERS GO IN THE ENVELOPE?

Unfortunately, no. Please reach out to your local health department.

#### WILL ANYONE SEE MY PERSONAL INFORMATION?

No, once you seal the TakeAway Envelope it is incinerated unopened.
