Dear Residents,

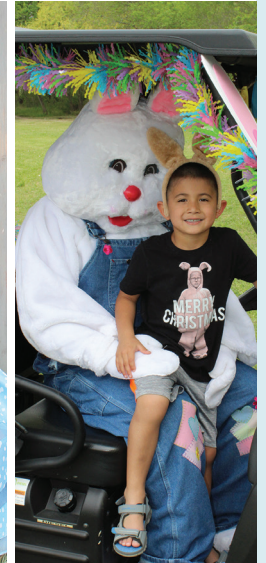

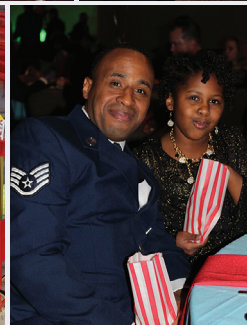

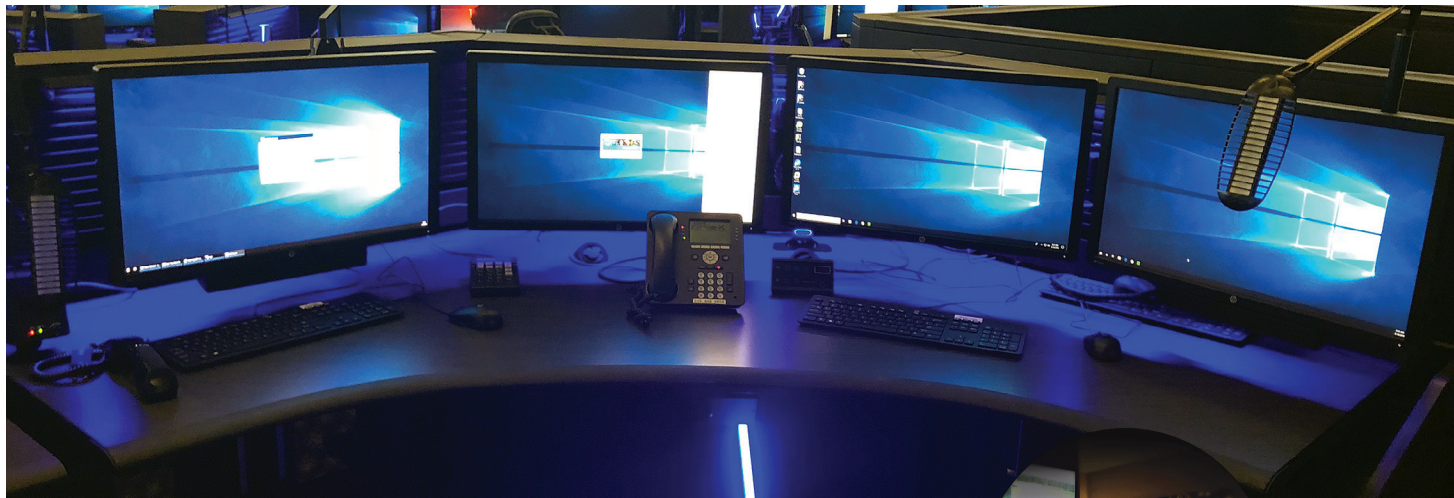

## National Public Safety Telecommunicators Week

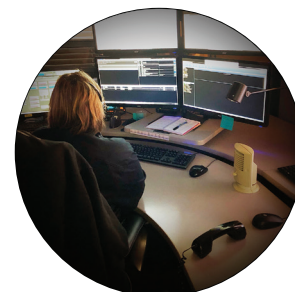

Your Live Oak Police Department consists of different divisions; Patrol, Criminal Investigations, Administrative, Animal Control and Communications. The latter of the divisions plays a critical role in law enforcement and safety of the community. The Communications Division of the Live Oak Police Department handles calls for service for Live Oak, Selma and Judson Independent School District. These calls for service are for Police, Fire, EMS and Animal Control Services. The communications center is staffed 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

The people who staff the communications center are certified through the State of Texas as Telecommunicator Officers, also known as TCO's. The TCO's are behind scenes with no visual contact with the public, but their role is critical to public safety. When a person calls the communications center through the non-emergency network or 911, they are probably having a bad day. The TCO will gather the necessary information, attempt to keep the person on the phone line and dispatch the appropriate agency or service in an expedient and efficient manner.

The TCO is a multi-tasker. They receive in-coming emergency phone calls, communicate with first responders in the field, run information checks and handle non-emergency communications. They collect and disseminate information quickly. They must make sure the information is correct and up to date. Public Safety personnel and citizens alike depend on them for critical and sometimes lifesaving information.

You won't find many television shows based on an emergency communications center. The networks leave that for Police and Fire Departments, but I can tell you that TCO's are a valuable resource for the safety of any community. The Live Oak Police Department would like to recognize our TCO's and thank them for what they do.

## Code Compliance Corner

It's that time of year for our semiannual bulk pick up event. This helpful service allows the residents to dispose of those unwanted items without having to spend money traveling to the garbage dump site. Although Waste Management collects almost all items placed on the curb, there are a few that are not permitted for pickup because of hazardous materials found in them. Automotive tires, televisions, paint, computer monitors and other electronic devices contain hazardous materials which require a different processing center to sequester the environmentally harmful components. That is why some items are left behind after the Waste Management truck passes through the neighborhood. Don't Panic!!!

Waste Management provides a free service where hazardous items can be scheduled for pickup by calling or contacting them via email. If code compliance contacts you about the hazardous items, simply provide the scheduled date so that we can follow up with you. It is vital that you take advantage of this free service to save you from issues with Code Compliance as well as having to pay to have the items removed.

Household hazardous waste items are a serious issue and must be handled correctly. Any hazardous items left outside without a scheduled pick up date will be considered a violation of City Ordinance 302.1 and a court summons will be issued for non-compliance. Please take the necessary steps to ensure that your hazardous household waste items are handled and disposed of properly.

## Did you know?

Residential Appliance Installers Authorized Scope of Work and Service for Pool-Related Electrical Devices. Residents or Businesses who need work on their pool system no longer will have to hire an electrician for items listed below. Texas Department of Licensing and Regulation (TDLR) have made changes to the requirements below. This allows the person with a residential appliance installer license (RAIL) to pull a permit to do the work. It still has to be installed by IAW manufacture's requirements and the National Electric Code NEC. The TDLR hereby provides additional scope of work and service guidance to political subdivisions, residential appliance installer license (RAIL) holders, and related stake holders regarding pool and spa work settings. Holders of a RAIL license may:

Install, uninstall, or replace pool-related electrical devices including underwater lights, ground-fault circuit interrupter (GFCI), pumps, motors, heaters, automation systems, and related equipment on the "load-side" of the control-center while maintaining National Electrical Code compliance. However, if the system requires a new or upgraded "line-circuit," only a licensed electrical contractor with a designated master electrician may offer to perform that work.

Install or add pool-related electrical devices to an existing pool that do not require an increase in amperage or access to a main breaker panel. For example, a RAIL holder may install salt systems, a time clock or similar automation equipment, a variable speed motor or ultraviolet or ozone equipment.

Install, uninstall, or replace pool-related electrical devices that use direct or alternating current.

In addition, a residential appliance dealer or manufacturer, or a person authorized by a dealer or manufacturer, may perform maintenance and repair of a pool-related electrical device. However, maintenance and repair may be performed using only components of the same type and ampacity as the original components. 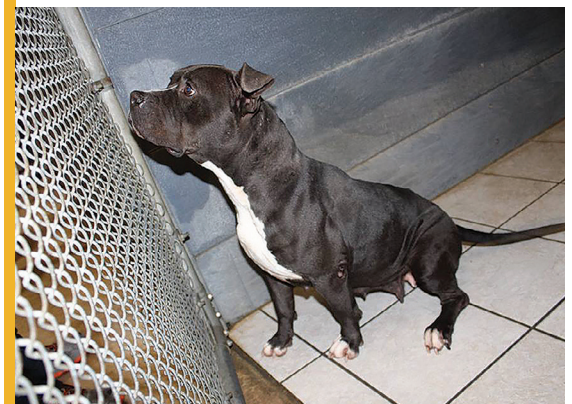

from the FIRE DEPT.



## Fire Hydrant Maintenance & Flushing

It's the time of year when the fire department performs fire hydrant testing, inspection and maintenance. Fall and spring seasons offer us the opportunity to test our fire hydrants twice a year and the test provides data to alert us to problems with our water system such as partially closed valves. Testing and flushing our fire hydrants twice a year gives us maximum credit on the Insurance Services Office (ISO) rating schedule which helps lower homeowner fire insurance premiums. The fire department will be using a water diffuser that will help prevent water damage to the surrounding landscaping around the fire hydrants. Below are pictures of the diffuser in use. Remember, the fire department needs clearance of at least 3 feet around each fire hydrant from any landscaping features or obstructions to be able to safely operate the fire hydrant in an emergency.

## Remember fire safety while spring cleaning

With the arrival of spring come blue skies, blooming flowers and spring cleaning. This is the perfect time for a refresher on fire safety tips that should be followed year-round. Keeping fire safety in mind when doing things around the house, like cleaning dryer's lint filter after each load of laundry, will help prevent fires.

**Fact:** The leading cause of home clothes dryer fires is failure to clean them.

- Clean the lint filter before or after each load of laundry.
- Remove lint that has collected around the drum.
- Keep the area around your dryer clear of things that can burn, like boxes, cleaning supplies and clothing.

**Fact:** Working smoke alarms cut the risk of dying in reported home fires in half.

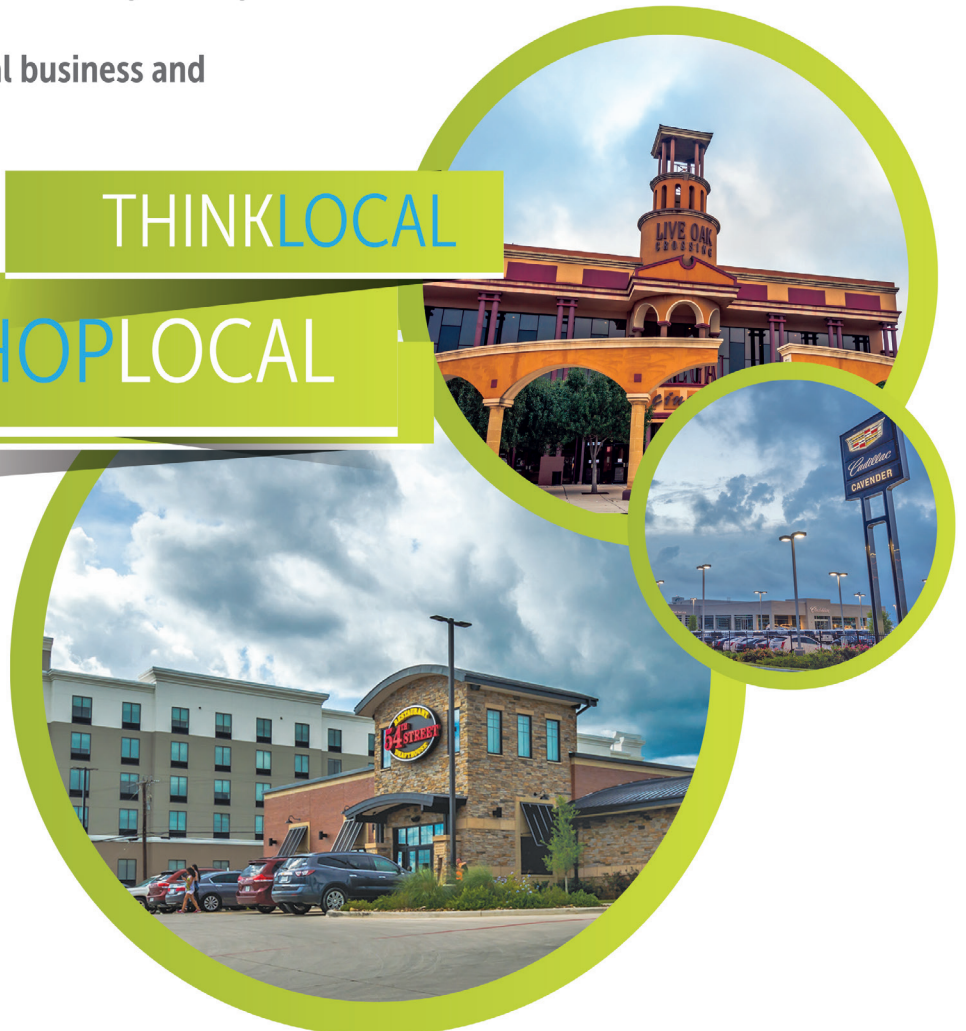

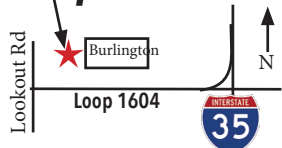
