Flooding in Live Oak Can Come With Little Warning.



SFHA is the area subject to inundation by a 100-year flood, as shown on the current Flood Insurance Rate Map (FIRM) compiled by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA). This notice is designed to make you more aware of local flood hazards, the need to keep flood insurance in force, and other topics related to flood preparedness. Please take a few minutes to review all of the items presented and determine what actions you may need to take in order to protect yourself.

Flooding in Live Oak can come with little warning. The flood in October of 1998 covered streets within 30 minutes of forming. Even though water over the streets appears to move slowly (three feet per second), a flood two-feet deep can knock a man off his feet and float a car.

Your property may be high enough that it was not flooded recently. However, it can still be flooded in the future because the next flood could be worse. This notice gives you some ideas of what you can do to protect yourself.

What You Can Do Ahead of Time:

- Rake up and bag leaves as often as possible before storms. Leaves clogging storm drains are the primary source of most floods. Do not dump or throw anything into drainage ditches or streams. Blocked drainage ways simply cannot carry water. When it rains, the water has to go somewhere. Every piece of litter contributes to flooding.
- Check with Live Oak's Development Services Department (210-653-9140, ext. 2244) before you build on, alter, regrade, or fill on your property. Permit(s) may be required to ensure that projects do not cause problems on other properties.
- Homeowner's insurance policies do not cover damage from floods. Get at least three quotes on flood insurance. If you do not have flood insurance, talk to your insurance agent.

During A Flood-Safety Tips:

- Do not walk through flowing water. Drowning is the number one cause of flood deaths, mostly during flash floods. Currents can be deceptive; six inches of moving water can knock you off your feet. If you walk in standing water, use a pole or stick to ensure the ground is still there.
- Do not drive through a flooded area. More people drown in their cars than anywhere else. Don't drive around road barriers because the road or bridge may be washed out.
- Stay away from power lines and electrical wires. The number two flood killer after drowning is electrocution. Electrical current can travel through water. Report downed power lines to City Public Service (CPS) or Live Oak's emergency management office/Fire Department.
- Have your electricity turned off by CPS. Some appliances, such as television sets, keep electrical charges even after they have been unplugged.

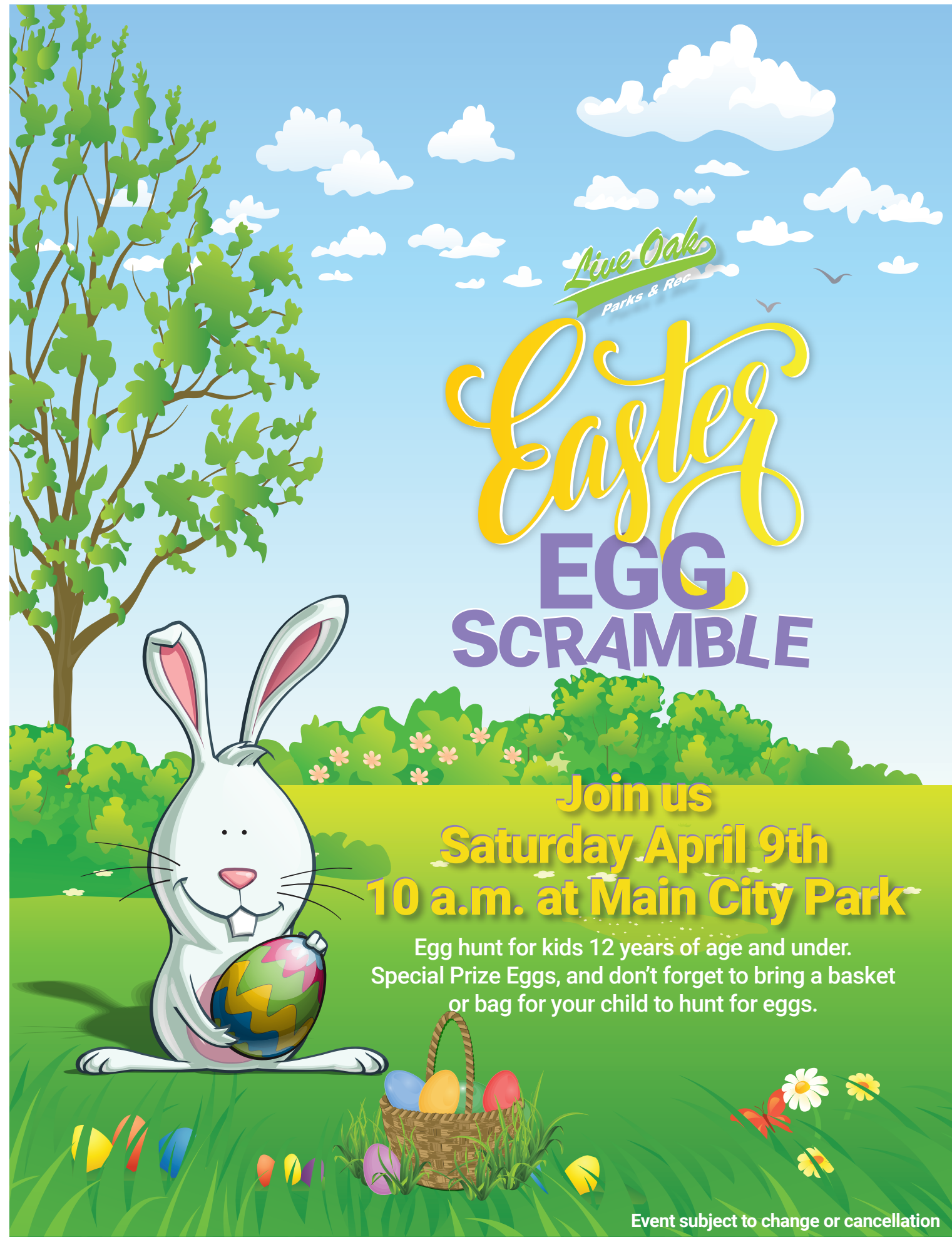

CHIEF DAN PUE RETIRES



Chief of Police Dan Pue's last day of service was December 30, 2021. He has faithfully served the citizens of Live Oak for 41 years. He began his career with the department as a Patrol Officer on November 1, 1980. He worked his way through the ranks serving as a Patrol Officer, Corporal, Sergeant, Detective, Lieutenant, Assistant Chief, becoming

Chief of Police in 2016. Chief Pue earned a Bachelor of Science degree from Southwest Texas State University in 1978, He is a graduate of the FBI National Academy and Texas Law Enforcement Command Management College of Texas A&M. His roles within the Police Department included Officer, Supervisor, Patrol Division Commander, and Criminal Investigations Division Commander. Under

his leadership as Assistant Chief he was instrumental in developing the Regional Radio Communications system which supports six municipalities and Judson Independent School District. He was also at the forefront as the project manager for the construction of the Live Oak Criminal Justice Center. He also led the way in the development of new department policies which gained the Department recognition with the Texas Police Chiefs Association, helping the Department become an accredited agency. This was quite the achievement as the Live Oak Police Department is now recognized as one of the 171 law enforcement agencies out of the 2,827 agencies in the state to be recognized for Best Practices in Texas Law Enforcement.

He has spent the last 41 years dedicated to the citizens of Live Oak and the Live Oak Police Department. He has been a great leader and a great friend to the city and department. He will be missed, but we wish him well with his future endeavors, and a well-deserved retirement. Chief Pue, we thank you for your service.

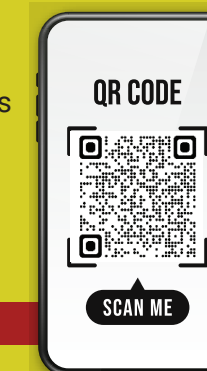

Information needed: 1) street address, 2) date(s), 3) hours, and 4) main items for sale (TV, Children's Toys, Dresser, etc.).



NOTE: The Citywide Garage Sales Event is subject to recommended COVID precautions.

Bulk Trash Pick Up

The semi-annual bulk trash pick-up begins Monday, March 21, 2022. Please place bulk items along the curb by Sunday evening, March 20th. Items cannot be placed at the curb before Tuesday, March 15th.

- **Examples of acceptable bulk items include:**
Chairs, sofas, mattresses, tables, water heaters, and lawn furniture.
- **The following items are unacceptable and will not be collected:**
Televisions, computers, monitors, refrigerators, window units, portable air conditioners or anything that contains Freon, tires, batteries, glass, household hazardous waste (see below for collection) and more than 2.5 cubic yards of Residential Construction Debris such as bricks, blocks or concrete
- **Waste Management will only pass by once.**
Please remember not to cover the sidewalk or water meter with your items, and do not park along the curb near the bulk items.

BRUSH SERVICE will be collected as usual, however, brush must be separated from bulk items.

Household Hazardous Waste DISPOSAL

Do you have old paint, pesticides, herbicides, batteries, fluorescent light bulbs, or electronic waste such as computers, monitors and laptops, which need to be disposed of? Call 1-800-449-7587 (M-F, 5am-5pm) and tell Waste Management that you are a Live Oak resident, and they will help you dispose of your hazardous waste.



Missing House Numbers

Could Mean Life or Death in an Emergency

The City of Live Oak, Texas has seen an increase in the number of homes in the city that DO NOT have house numbers.

Having numbers on your residence can decrease the amount of time that Fire, EMS, and Police take to reach your home in an emergency, even a few minutes of delay can mean life or death. So, help us save your life by placing house numbers on your home with these guidelines.

Guidelines:

- Clearly seen from street
- Numbers must contrast with their background
- Minimum of 4 inches in height
- Minimum stroke width of 0.5 inches
- Illuminated by a light of at least 60 Watts

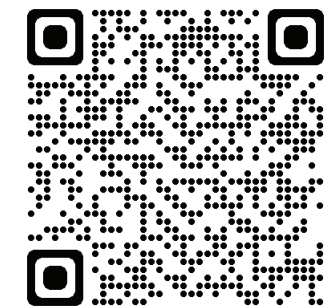
Are You Prepared For A Disaster?

4. What is my family communication plan?

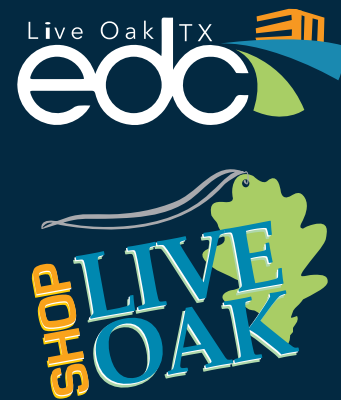
