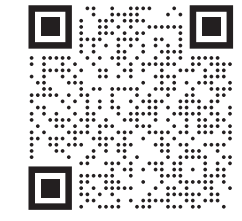

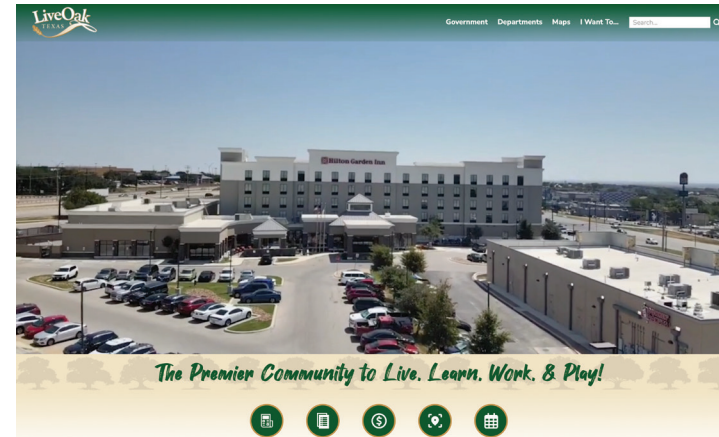

## The 21st Annual Live Oak Summer Open Disc Golf Tournament

Scheduled for May 3rd- May 5th. Commonly referred to as L.O.S.O., this event is the longest running disc golf tournament in the San Antonio area. Approximately three hundred players will come from all over Texas and the United States to play at the Joe Painter Live Oak Hillside and Live Oak Lakeside courses. L.O.S.O. is classified by the Professional Disc Golf Association (P.D.G.A.) as an A-Tier event in 2024 due to the historical nature of the event and the generous sponsorship of the City of Live Oak, Mint Discs, Lucky Ace Discs, and Alamo Community Disc Club.

Disc Golf is one of the fastest growing outdoor sports across the nation. The two Live Oak courses are some of the most popular in the area with over 11k rounds recorded annually in 2023 by players on the popular disc golf score-keeping app UDisc. **WHAT HAPPENS TO THE ENVELOPE AFTER IT IS MAILED?**  
The envelopes containing the medications are sent directly to a treatment facility to be incinerated.

**ARE TAKEAWAY ENVELOPES SAFE?**  
Yes, the TakeAway Envelopes are safe. Using the TAE is safer than flushing or throwing the medications in the trash. Incinerating the medications limit the environmental damage that medications can have by preventing them from polluting our drinking water.

**The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) recommends incineration as the method of drug destruction, which meets the Department of Enforcement Agency's (DEA) standard.**

**CAN NEEDLES OR INHALERS GO IN THE ENVELOPE?**  
Unfortunately, no. Please reach out to your local health department.

**WILL ANYONE SEE MY PERSONAL INFORMATION?**  
No, once you seal the TakeAway Envelope it is incinerated unopened.

#### What information are we collecting and publishing?

#### What about garage sale signs?

- With your neighbor's permission, in their yard
- In your own yard
- NOT in the city right of way
- NOT against curbs
- NOT against the street side of the sidewalk
- All signs must be removed no later than 24 hours after your garage sale ends.

### What about the stuff you don't sell?

**BULK PICK-UP BEGINS ON MONDAY, MAY 6, 2024.** You may place your bulk items at the curb no sooner than Wednesday, May 1, 2024, and no later than Sunday, May 5, 2024. Citywide bulk pick-up can take up to TWO WEEKS to complete.

*We will pass by your residence ONCE. Do not cover the sidewalk or water meter with your bulk items, and do not block your items by parking vehicles in front of them.*

#### Examples of Bulk Items:

Chairs, sofas, mattresses, tables, empty water heaters, lawn furniture AND MORE!

#### NOT acceptable Bulk Items:

Televisions, computer monitors, refrigerators, window units, portable A/C units or anything else that contains freon, tires, batteries, glass, hazardous materials, or waste.

3. **Preparation** - involves having a plan in place in case of a fire, including an evacuation route and a designated meeting place.

## Spring is upon us

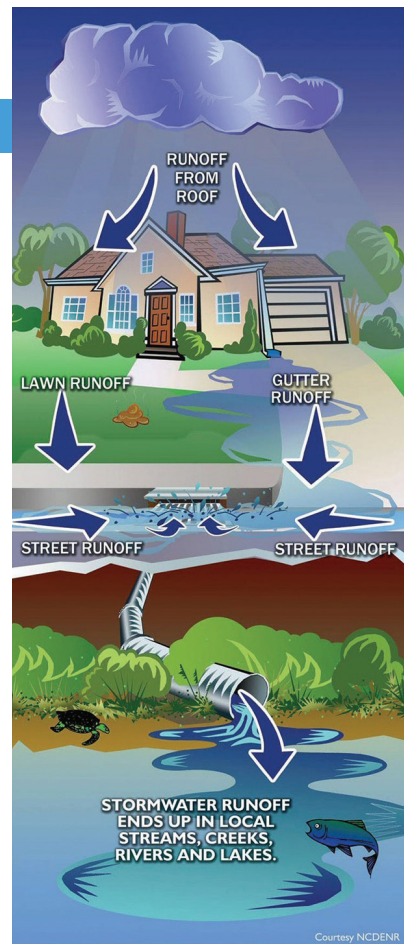
### What does this mean in the Public Works world?

Our residents will be spring cleaning, planting, and sprucing up their lawns. The City of Live Oak is dedicated to water conservation, pollution control, and keeping our waterways clean and safe for our wildlife and communities. Fertilizer, pet waste, pesticides, and litter can run off from your lawn and into our storm water system; therefore, polluting our environment.

#### While you are out there making Live Oak a beautiful place:

- Clean up after your pets and your projects.
- Use recommended amounts of fertilizer and pesticides. Read the labels and don't overdo it.
- Reduce the amount of grease, fats, and oils that go down your drains.
- Avoid watering in the middle of the day when water droplets can evaporate in midday heat.
- Check for leaks inside and outside of your home. If you see issues, fix them right away.
- Mind the Edwards Aquifer watering restrictions.

### Reduce storm water pollution

Pet waste is more than just a gross and unsightly mess. It's an environmental pollutant and a serious health hazard. When left on the ground, waste eventually breaks down and washes into the storm drains, polluting our rivers, streams, creeks, and other local waterways.

Pet waste can be a major source of bacteria, nitrogen, phosphorus, and parasites that threaten the health of people and animals. Pet waste improperly disposed of can lead to conditions in local water bodies that are unsafe for human recreation and negatively impact aquatic life.

#### WHAT CAN YOU DO?

- Always pick-up after your pet. Pet waste is NOT fertilizer.
- Avoid walking your pet near streams & waterways. Instead, walk them in grassy areas, parks, or underdeveloped areas.
- Carry disposable bags while walking your dog. Pick up and dispose of it in the trash.
- Flush it down the toilet. (without the bag)
- Spread the message. Inform other pet owners of why picking up pet waste is important and encourage them to do so.

### Illegal Dumping

Illegal dumping is the disposal of waste in an unpermitted area, such as the back of a yard, along a stream bank, in an alley, in a public right of way, or at other off-road areas. Pouring liquid waste or disposing of trash down storm drains is a form of illegal dumping that can qualify as an illicit discharge.

Litter is often the result of poorly managed trash. This trash is carried by wind or rain into a storm sewer system or directly to a lake, stream, or river.

#### Tips for dealing with trash

- Never litter.
- Put trash in the appropriate bins.
- Do not leave trash next to or on top of an overflowing bin.

#### Take the following steps to prevent trash from escaping from your outdoor trash bins on collection day.

- Keep your lid closed and do not overfill the trash bin.
- Put trash outside shortly before pick-up.

PLEASE NOTE: The city has authority to assess fines for illegal dumping.

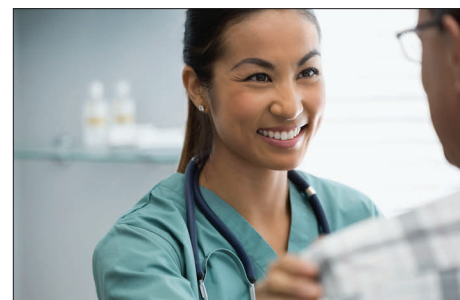

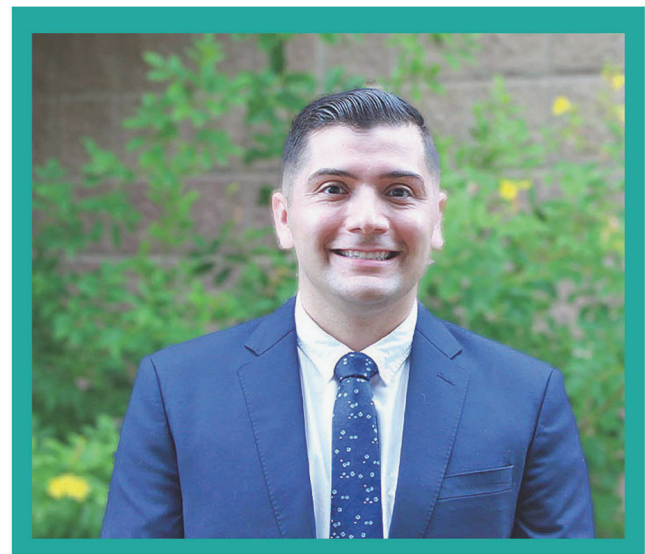
