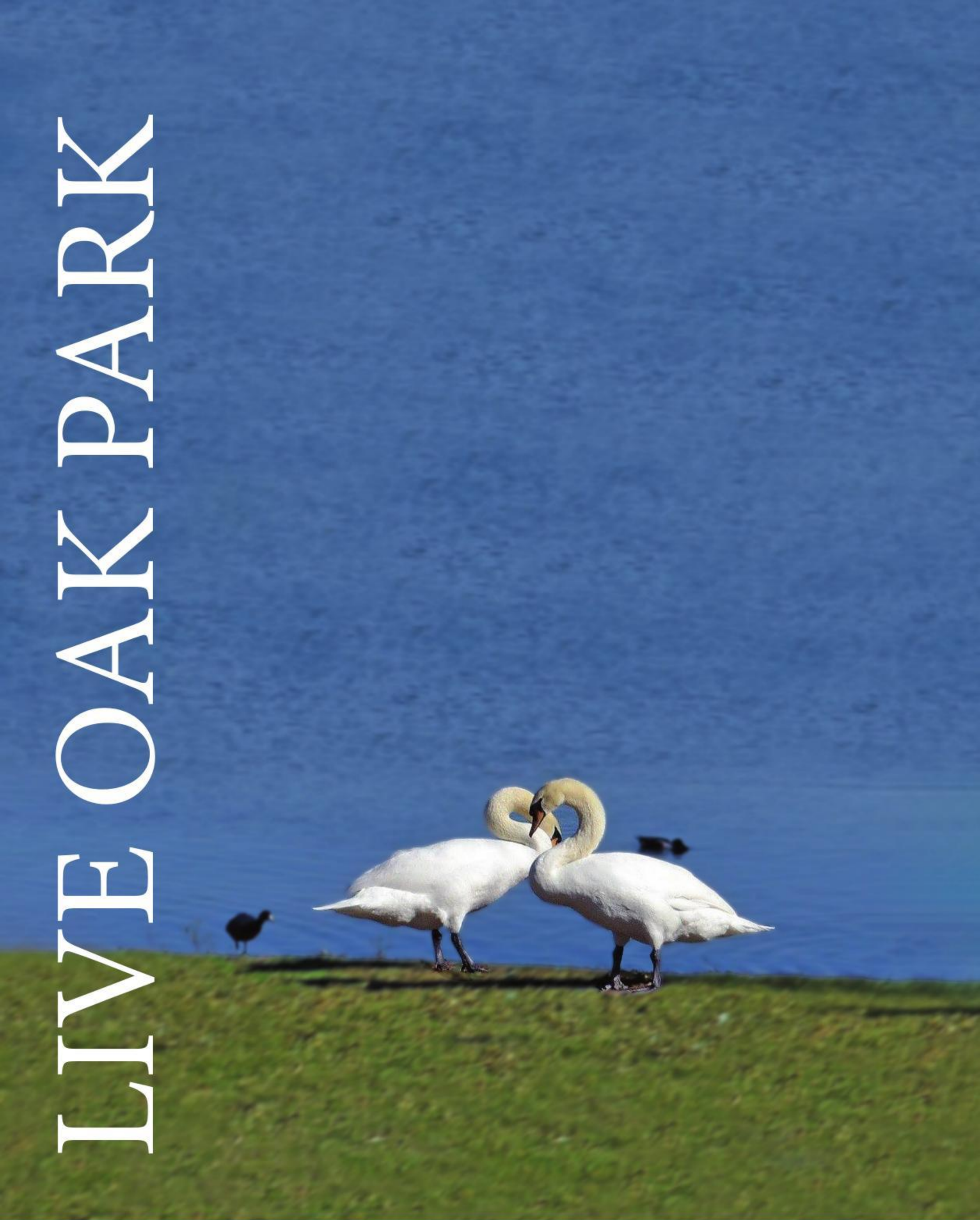

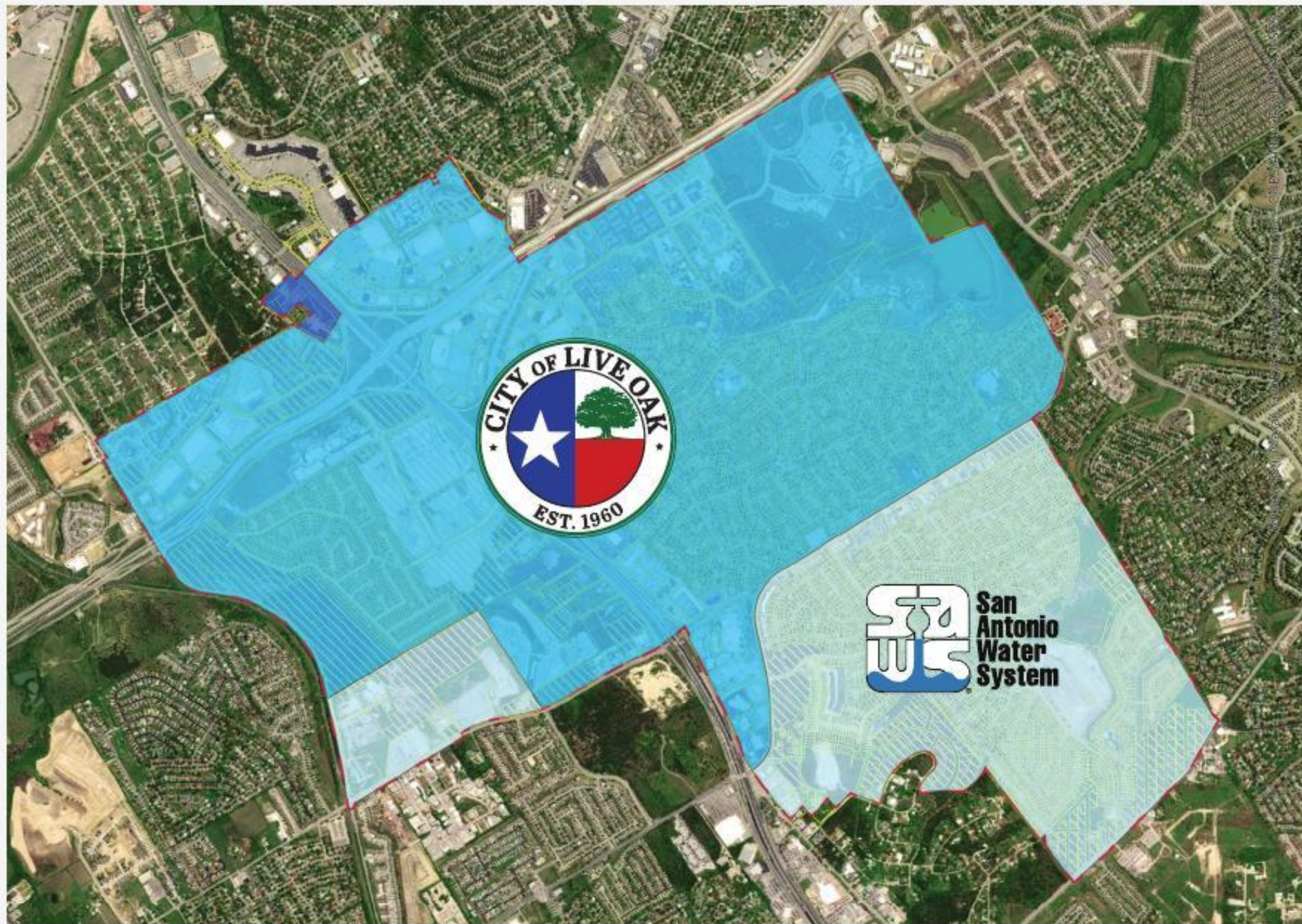

Who Provides My Water?

This recent winter storm impacted the city with power outages and travel issues, and highlighted the need of the city to share information about the City's water system and its providers. The portion of Live Oak that is northeast of Toepperwein, as well as the Bridlewood Subdivision are served by the Live Oak water system. As a city, we own a water system consisting of three wells, and four elevated ground storage tanks, along with the conveyance lines that distribute the water.

The remainder of Live Oak, primarily the area south of Toepperwein and Judson, are served by the San Antonio Water System (SAWS). When the city of San Antonio released the area so that Live Oak could annex it in the 1970's, they retained the rights to provide that portion of Live Oak with water. This arrangement comes with pros and cons. One thing that became apparent as the result of the storm, was the need to identify these two subsets

of residents within the city, and to explore how they are treated differently in terms of how they pay for, how to report issues, and most importantly, how to identify which areas are served by which provider.

When SAWS issued a boil water notice for their customers, we identified the need to better inform our residents and most importantly our businesses, on which system serves them and to ensure residents are taking the proper steps to protect themselves. This issue impacted both commercial and residential customers alike and Live Oak will be working on a type of identification system so customers will be better informed. In the meantime, if you have any questions about your water provider, or any other issue regarding the water services provided, please do not hesitate to contact the City of Live Oak at 210-653-9140 ext. 2234.

Gearing up for Summer Safety



The Live Oak Fire Department would like to remind everyone, as the summer months near, to be safe.

- Stay Hydrated. Drink 8 or more glasses of water per day to stay healthy and hydrated.
- Know the side effects of medication. Some medications have side effects such as drowsiness or sun sensitivity.
- Stay cool. Stay in the A/C, or GO SWIMMING!!!!
- Wear light, loose-fitting clothing. Wear breathable clothing and light colors that reflect the sun.
- Have emergency contacts. Make a list of people to call in case of emergency.
- Bike helmets. These should cover the forehead and sit level on the child's head. Fasten the helmet tight enough so only two fingers fit between the chin and strap.

Never forget to plan ahead and start to build a disaster supply kit. Some basic items to place in your kit should be:

- Water – one gallon per person per day for several days, for drinking and sanitation
- Food – at least a three-day supply of non-perishable food
- Battery-powered or hand-crank radio for emergency broadcast
- Flashlight
- Extra batteries
- Dust mask
- Wrench or pliers to turn off utilities
- Manual can opener
- Local map
- Cell phone with chargers and a backup battery

Emergency shelters will be opened when people are displaced from their homes. In most situations, emergency shelters are operated by the American Red Cross. Be prepared to make a go-bag for emergency sheltering. You may need to bring a pillow and blanket, identification, change of clothes, comfort items, medication and medical supplies. The Red Cross will provide a cot to sleep on, meals and water, basic medical care, and information about the disaster from local officials. Emergency shelters prohibit weapons and alcohol, as well as pets unless they are certified service animals.

Help Us Prevent Flooding in Your Neighborhood



The City of Live Oak's Utility/Storm Water department performs cleaning and maintenance activities on the drainage channels and pipes in City easements & rights-of-way in accordance with an established schedule and other standard operating procedures. Residents are encouraged to assist in maintaining the drainage in their areas by removing or reporting obstructions (such as tree limbs, leaves, debris, trash, etc.). Keeping drainage channels free of obstructions reduces flooding in the event of heavy rains. By way of City ordinance, it is illegal to dump trash, leaves, landscape debris, paint, grease, or any other material into any portion of the City's drainage system. Such dumping can have devastating impacts on water quality in addition to causing flooding. To report obstructions or illegal dumping, or for questions regarding drainage system maintenance, please contact Storm Water Maintenance at 210-653-9140, ext. 2224.

Permitting Requirements

Did you know that all development within the city requires a permit? Always check and fulfill permitting requirements with Development Services department at (210) 653-9140, extension 2244, before you build on, alter, fill, or re-grade on any portion of your property and/or within any easement or

right-of-way. This construction or re-grading may alter the flow of water during a flood causing damage or backup to your home or your neighbor's home. Also, contact the number above to report any suspected permitting violations.

Cyber Security Recognition

Road Construction

Road construction is inevitable. Our city and surrounding area continue to grow with new homes and businesses. As the population increases, so do the traffic problems. The Pat Booker/Loop 1604 area has been under construction for some time. This has caused traffic congestion and extended travel times. It not only affects these main

thoroughfares, but residential streets. Detours and drivers finding alternative routes increases traffic through residential neighborhoods. Remember, the posted speed limit on residential streets in Live Oak is 20 mph! Speeding drivers put pedestrians and other motorists in danger.

Due to the higher volume of traffic and increased driver speeds of drivers, the police department has stepped up traffic enforcement in these affected areas. If you are speeding, you will be stopped for the violation. You will be issued a citation with a date to appear in Municipal Court. Your best option is to leave earlier and allow additional time to reach your destination. Speeding to and from work, school, or shopping is not worth a person's life. Remember, to be patient, courteous, and safe.



Vehicle and Property Security

Vehicle burglaries are crimes of opportunity. They can occur overnight in a driveway or in daylight in a parking lot. Remember to hide valuables or take them with you when you leave your vehicle. Make sure your windows are up and doors are locked. Thieves look for items to steal. They check vehicle doors and rummage through unlocked vehicles. If you leave items such as phones, laptops, purses, or other valuables in plain sight, you could return to a vehicle with valuables gone and/or a broken window or door lock. Help us help you. If you can, park your vehicle in your garage. If that is not an option, remove valuables from your vehicle when you arrive at your destination. Don't give thieves an opportunity to steal. We at the Live Oak Police Department are your partners. Together we can build and keep a community where people are safe to live, work, and play.



Connect CTY Telephone Alert System

In the event of an emergency, the Connect CTY Telephone Alerting System will be the primary means of notifying our citizens. The Live Oak Communications Center (dispatch) has direct access and can prepare and send a message within minutes. As such, we encourage all citizens to keep their telephone numbers up-to-date in the system. This includes your land line along with your cellular numbers for telephone calls and text messages. You can also include an e-mail address if you desire.

In addition to emergency messages, the City may use the system to pass along important information like street closures or water outages. On occasion the city, may send out a call regarding City events in the park or parades. As a reminder, there are NO individual costs for this emergency service and the database is secure.

While many citizens appreciate the City's efforts to keep them informed, others may not. Therefore, citizens have the option and capability to remove their numbers from the database. In order to update telephone numbers or remove them from the Connect CTY database, citizens may simply go to the City's website. Under "Residents" tab, select the Connect CTY item and follow the instructions. A word of caution, however! As noted earlier, this telephone system is the City's primary means of communicating with its citizens in an emergency.

One last item. If you are planning to move out of the City and keep your same home phone numbers, you will continue to receive calls unless you delete your name, and numbers.



National Police Week



National Police Week will be observed on May 9-15th this year. It's a moment for us to pay special recognition to those law enforcement officers who have lost their lives in the line of duty for the safety and protection of others. Each year, Live Oak places a wreath at the Araiza Memorial in honor and remembrance of Live Oak's very own fallen officer Alfredo Araiza who gave his life in the line of duty on January 17, 1980.

Officer Araiza, in the face of extreme danger, did not waiver in his bravery and duty to pursue the escaping violent criminals. He is remembered to always having a smile on his face as he went about his job. He loved his job and serving the community. He is survived by his devoted, wife Mari.



Permitting

With the recent ice storm and cold weather, a lot of citizens may have concerns about the safety of their homes, especially in regard to power. One way to help improve the safety of your home is to check to see if your electrical panel or breaker has been recalled or has safety issues. Many homes in Live Oak were built prior to 1990, and if so, the home could have been built with electrical breakers from brands like Zinsco Breakers, Federal Pacific Breakers (FPE), or Challenger Type "A" Electrical Panels. These brands may not pass a current electrical inspection and could even be recalled for safety issues.



Now that the cold weather is behind us, this would be a great time to have a licensed electrician come out to take a look at your electrical panel for any safety issues, recalls, or replacements that might be needed. Licensed electrician information can be found through the Texas Department of Licensing and Regulation at tdlr.texas.gov/LicenseSearch. If you have questions, please call Building Official Jake Schmidtke at (210) 653-9140, extension 2250, for assistance. We look forward to making all homes in Live Oak a safe place to live.



Code Corner

Where there is warm weather, there are weeds!

Warmer weather is creeping in, and with that comes lots and lots of weeds. It seems like overnight, the weeds are growing back after you have just mowed. We understand weeds are a lot of work, especially in the spring and summer here in Live Oak.

This is a friendly reminder that the city's ordinances do not allow weeds or grass to be over twelve (12) inches on any property and that any grass clippings blown into the street or left in the street after mowing or lawn maintenance are not allowed.

Helpful Tip: After mowing, take a leaf blower and blow all leftover grass clippings back into the grass, getting the clippings off the street and sidewalks. This prevents the clippings from accumulating and you from receiving a notice from the Code Compliance team.

Sometimes life happens during the grass/weed growing season, such as vacations, family emergencies, etc., preventing you from taking care of the grass/weeds yourself. Another helpful tip would have a lawn service or neighbor help you keep your weeds cut while you're out of town. There are many reputable online lawn services that let you book with them directly through their website, and this can help when you are on the go or if you forget while you are out of town. From your friendly, neighborhood Code Compliance team, thank you for your help keeping the city looking beautiful. We are open from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Friday (closed between 12-1pm). 

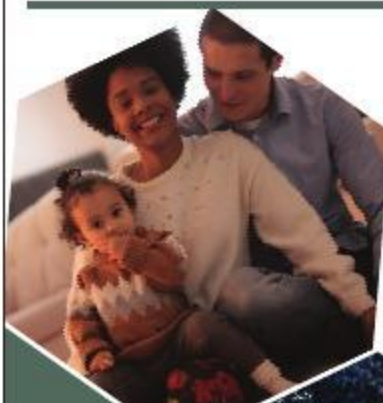
