Important Changes to your Trash Collection Services

New Bulky Item Collection

Bulky item curbside collection is now available on the first Monday of every month. Place acceptable items at the curb no later than 6:00 AM on the first Monday of the month. The weekend prior to the first Monday is the best time to place these bulky items on the grass at the curb. Please make sure no vehicles are blocking access for collection and allow 7 days for pick up.

Acceptable items include:

- Appliances without Freon such as washing machines, dryers, and dishwashers.
- Carpet (cut into 4-foot bundles)
- Furniture and mattresses
- Sinks, toilets, and drained or empty water heaters.

Unacceptable items that will not be picked up:

- Appliances with Freon such as refrigerators, window air conditioners, or freezers.
- Batteries and paint.
- Concrete, brick, asphalt, and roofing.
- Construction debris from a contractor.
- Gasoline, oil, oil filters.
- Pesticides and chemicals.
- Tires, and car parts.

New Monthly Brush Collection

Monthly curbside brush collection is now available the first Monday of every month. Place brush bundles at the curb no later than 6:00 AM on the first Monday of the month. The weekend prior to the first Monday is the best time to place the bundled brush at the curb. Please make sure no vehicles are blocking access for collection and allow 7 days for pick up.

- Brush limbs may not exceed four feet (4') in length.
- Limbs must be tied into manageable bundles weighing less than fifty pounds (50 lbs.)

Frequently Asked Questions

Why is Waste Management replacing the 2-man rear loading trash trucks with a 1-man driver operated automated collection truck?

The primary reason is employee safety. Severe injury and fatalities have occurred from workers being exposed to motor vehicle traffic, the hydraulic compactor at the rear of the truck, and physically handling bags of trash. The employee operating the automated side loading truck remains in the truck during entire trash collection process.

When will Live Oak residents receive the 96-gallon wheeled trash and recycle carts?

Current supply chain challenges have placed the delivery time for the new wheeled carts at 5 to 6 months. Therefore, the new carts should arrive by September of this year. Please check the city web site www.liveoaktx.net and keep an eye on the electronic marquee signs for updates.

Can I get a smaller cart or use my own trash can?

Unfortunately, only one size (96-gallon) is available for all residents. The automated system is only able to load the Waste Management cart. Residents will not be able to use their own cans.

If I choose not to recycle, then can I opt out of the 96-gallon recycling cart?

All residents will receive a wheeled recycle cart. Any resident that chooses not to recycle may have the recycle cart returned or picked up. The monthly fee will remain the same even if residents turn in the recycle cart.

What about residents with serious physical challenges that prevent them from handling the 96-gallon wheeled trash cart?

A "Door-to-Truck Service" is available on a case-by-case basis for those residents who have demonstrated a need or hardship necessitating this special service. The WM truck operator will roll the trash cart to the truck for service and return it to the side of the resident's home.

Will I be charged an additional fee on my bill for the wheeled trash and recycle carts?

There is no additional fee or special charge for the carts. All residents in Live Oak will pay the same monthly charge of \$25.31 and the cost of the carts is factored into the new rate.

Will residents be violating any city laws by placing their trash carts on the side of their house or in front of their garage?

The city does not prohibit trash carts from being placed on the side or in front of a home. However, if you live in subdivision with a Home Owners Association (HOA), then you may want to review the rules and regulations of the HOA.

Automated Side Loader Collection ASL

WM will operate residential collection with new compressed natural gas (CNG) powered Automated Side Loader (ASL) collection trucks.

WM will furnish a 96-gallon wheeled trash cart and a 96-gallon wheeled recycling cart to all residential customers. Carts will be delivered in 5 to 6 months.

ASL Collection will not start until the new carts arrive. The city will provide more information about this process before the carts are delivered.

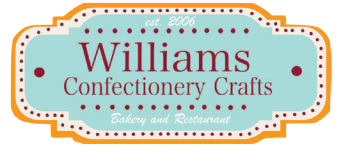

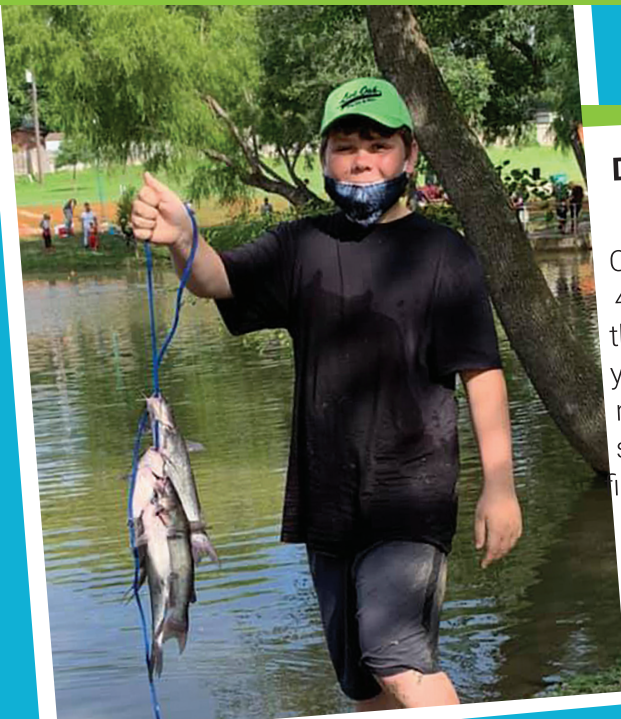
Dust off the rods and reels; it is Junior Fishing Day at the Live Oak Park Lakeside!

Vehicle Security

In past issues, we have discussed securing your vehicle. We are normally referring to the contents of your vehicle, especially during the Christmas season. This is a high time of vehicle burglaries as people shop and leave purchased items in their vehicles.

We would now like to address the security of your vehicle itself, more directly, vehicle parts. Due to the rising cost, gasoline and diesel and auto parts thefts of catalytic converters have increased dramatically.

Catalytic converters became mandatory equipment in 1975, so just about every vehicle on the road now has one as part of the exhaust system. Catalytic converters contain three precious metals, platinum, palladium, and rhodium. As the price of these metals has risen, thefts have increased. The stolen converters are sold to scrap metal salvage companies. A thief with a cordless power tool can have your catalytic converter off your car or your fuel tank drained within five minutes.

Another new trend is fuel theft. Thieves no longer use a siphon hose to get a few gallons. Brazen thieves are now crawling under vehicle, drilling a hole in the fuel tank, and draining all the fuel! This can be quite the loss to a victim with a 20-gallon fuel tank with gas and diesel running between four and five dollars a gallon.

The best way to protect yourself from becoming a victim at home is to park your car in your garage. If you don't have a garage, use outdoor security lighting to deter thieves. When away from home, park your vehicle in high traffic areas of parking lots. If you own a business and have company vehicles parked overnight, make sure they are parked in secured, well-lit areas.

Hopefully, these tips will help protect your property and wallet. Remember, see something suspicious, say something and call the police. Together we can keep our city a safe place to live, work, and play.

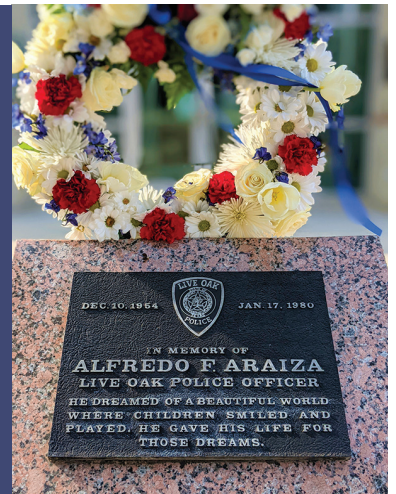

Are you creating a potential fire in your home and not realize it?

Are you creating a potential fire in your home, but not realizing it?

The Live Oak Fire Department would like you to remember to clean your lint filter and dryer vents. These are important things to remember because they can contribute to a house fire. Here are simple tips to prevent a clothes dryer fire.

- Have your dryer installed and serviced by a professional.
- Do not use the dryer without a lint filter.
- Clean the lint filter before and after each cycle.
- Do not forget to clean the back of the dryer where lint can build up.
- Check the venting system behind the dryer to make sure that it is not damaged, crushed, or restricted.
- Make sure the outdoor vent covering opens when the dryer is operating.

Chapter 8. Article III. Sec 8-43 Prohibited.
 It shall be unlawful for any person to manufacture, assemble, store, transport, receive, keep, sell, offer, or have in his possession with intent to sell, use, discharge, cause to be discharged, ignite, detonate, fire or otherwise set in action any fireworks of any description.

Leave the fireworks to the professionals and visit a safe professional fireworks show.

We probably remember to change out smoke detectors batteries at least once(1) a year, but how often do we remember to check the carbon monoxide detector?



Referencing First Alert, if your carbon monoxide alarm has replaceable batteries, they should be changed at least every six (6) months. Carbon monoxide poisoning is common during the winter months as we start to use heating appliances. You can also contact the Live Oak Fire Department at (210) 653-9140, extension 2379 and inquire about smoke alarms and the Kemeth Cole Carbon Monoxide Detector programs.

Here are some steps to a fire escape plan:

- Draw a floor plan for each floor of your home, including windows and doors. For each room, find two ways out, and label them on your plan.
- Designate one adult to help get babies, young children, and family members who need extra help getting out safely. Have a back-up plan in case the primary person is overcome by smoke or is not at home.
- Decide on a safe meeting place for the family. Make sure it is a safe distance away from the home.
- Make sure everyone knows what to do and where to go in case of fire.
- Test your smoke alarms twice a year.
- Teach your child to get low and crawl on the ground, where the air is less smoky.
- Practice your fire escape plan twice a year.
