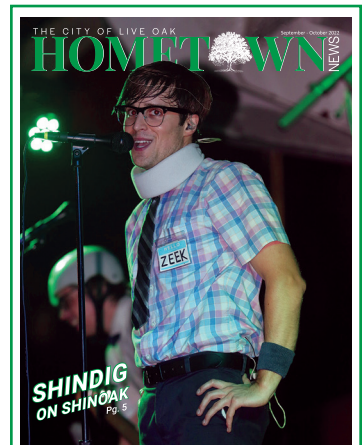

Community Shred Day - Results



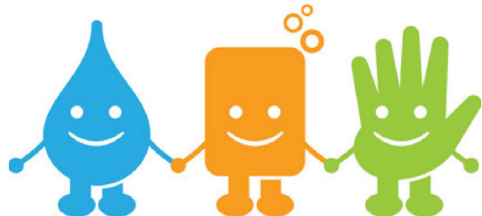

The total recycled was 20,000 pounds or 10 tons of paper waste.

Since the City began the Shred Program, 317,286 pounds of paper waste for recycling has been shredded.

Protect Yourself with Flood Insurance

A few inches of rain can cause flooding conditions, and water inside a residential structure can easily cause tens of thousands of dollars in damage. Even though Live Oak has had only a few claims, if you experience any damage caused by water, flood insurance is the only way to protect yourself from devastating losses.

Flood insurance is available to homeowners, condo owners, commercial owners, and renters. The costs vary depending on how much insurance is purchased, what it covers, and the flood risk to the property.

All policies provide coverage for buildings and their contents. However, you might want to discuss insuring personal property with your agent, since contents coverage is optional. There is typically a 30-day waiting period from date of purchase before your policy goes into effect. So the sooner you act, the better.

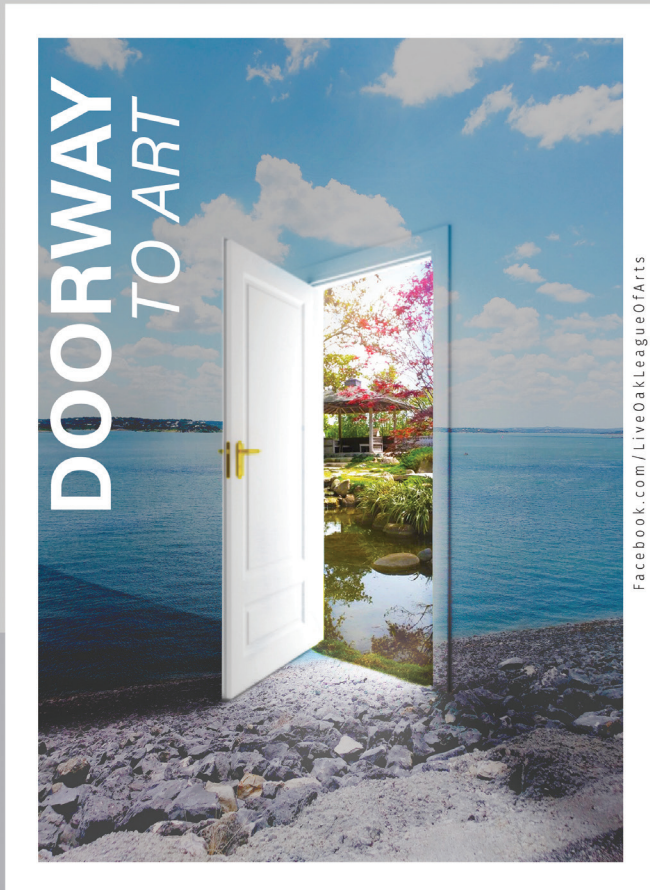

Congratulations Graduates

The Live Oak Police Department would like to congratulate the recent graduates of the Citizens Police Academy (CPA) and the Junior Police Academy (JPA). We had a two-year break from these programs due to the pandemic and we are proud to say they are back.

The CPA hosted eleven participants this year. The academy was 10 weeks long and met one evening every week. The citizens were exposed to a variety of topics including city government, patrol tactics and strategies, traffic enforcement, criminal investigations, emergency response team, and police K-9 operations. The participants graduated with an understanding of their police department and how it operates. The graduates are now eligible to join the LOCAP group which is Live Oak Citizens Assisting Police (CPA).

The JPA was held June 13 – 17. Thirty-six inquisitive young cadets attended this year. They learned about police core values, teamwork, responsibility, Emergency Response Team operations, K-9, site tours, and the police applicant obstacle course. It was fun for cadets and officers as well as for our LOCAP volunteers and JPA alumni who returned to assist.

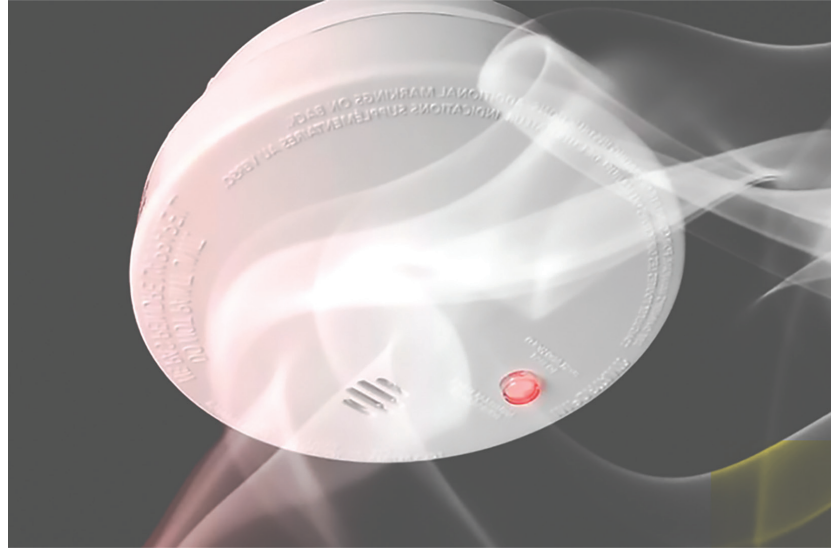

Smoke Detector Batteries

Remember to change out smoke detectors batteries at least once (1) a year, but how often do we remember to check the Carbon Monoxide detector. Referencing First Alert, if your carbon monoxide alarm has replaceable batteries, they should be changed at least every six (6) months. Carbon Monoxide poisoning is common during the winter months as we start to use heating appliances. You can also contact the Live Oak Fire Department at 210-653-9140 ext 2379 and inquire about both Smoke alarm and Kemeth Cole Carbon Monoxide Detector programs.

The \$18 million bond was approved by voters during the May election to be used for repairing and maintaining major collector streets within the city. The LOEDC will be able to contribute to the payment because the street repairs and maintenance meet the criteria for an EDC-permissible project, and the money contributes to new and expanded business development.

Water we save is water we do not have to buy. It is important to do everything we can to decrease our water consumption. Plumbing fixture retrofits, water saver landscapes, and improved habits are all things that will help make low water use a part of our everyday life.



Reduce Storm Water Pollution

Illegal Dumping

Illegal dumping is the disposal of waste in an un-permitted area, such as in the back of a yard, along a stream bank, in an alley, in a public right-of-way, or at other off-road areas. Pouring liquid wastes or disposing of trash down storm drains is a form of illegal dumping that can also qualify as an illicit discharge.

Litter is often the result of poorly managed trash. This trash is carried by wind or rain into a storm sewer system or directly to a lake, stream, or river.

Tips for Dealing with Trash

- Never litter. Put trash in the appropriate bins, and do not leave trash next to or on top of an overflowing bin. Prevent trash from escaping from your outdoor trash bins on collection day.
- The city has authority to assess fines for illegal dumping.

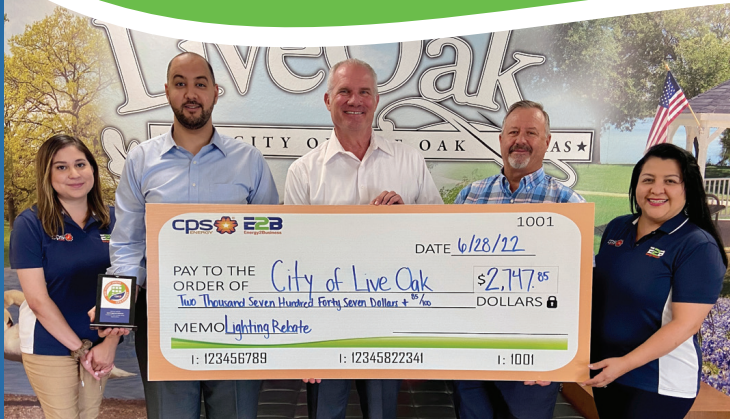
Week 4 - Teach Youth About Preparedness:

What Exactly Makes a Vehicle Inoperative or Unlicensed?

This is a friendly reminder from the City of Live Oak, Code Compliance office to make sure any vehicles parked on your property follow our City's code. Section 302.8 of the Code of Ordinances does not allow inoperative or unlicensed motor vehicles to be kept or stored on any premises.



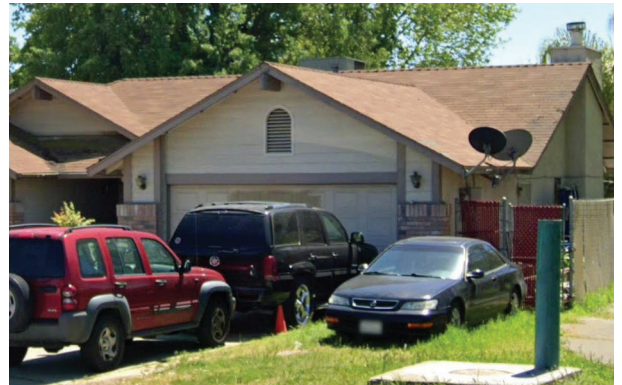
Examples of an inoperative or unlicensed vehicle are:

- Expired or no registration
- Missing license plate, flat tire(s), in disrepair, wrecked, abandoned, and/or incapable of being moved under its own power.



Additionally, the code does not allow vehicles to be parked on an unpaved surface. Paved surfaces include pavement, concrete, asphalt, or pavers. Any vehicles parked, even partially, on the grass are in violation of Section 302.8.

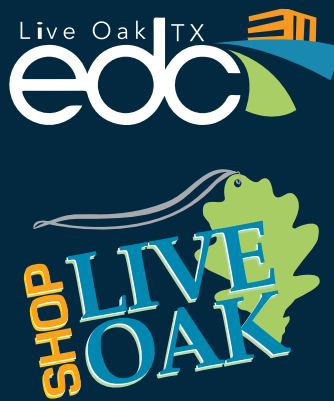

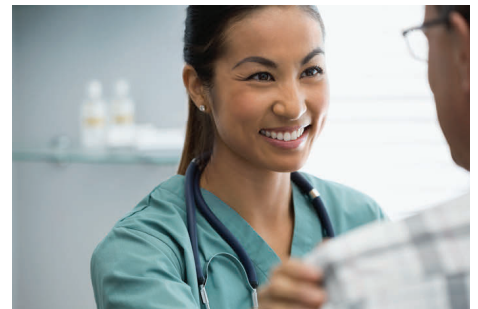


